In severe cases the skin may show pimples, boils, redness, black and blue spots, hives and blisters. Iodides are readily diffused across the placenta. Neonatal deaths from

respiratory distress secondary to goiter have been reported. Iodides have been known to cause drug-induced fevers, which are usually of

short duration.
